Thiebald Cremers, PhD, graduated from the Paris 2 Pantheon-Assas University in General private law. His post-graduate specialisation is in financial law and in the history of private law.

He was an observer for EuropeanIssuers at the Unidroit Diplomatic conferences negotiating the Geneva Securities Convention and he was as representative for France at the working group between the European Commission and the Council on the future Securities Law Directive, as well as a member of the French delegation negotiating the Unidroit Close-out netting principles.

In his academic functions, he taught the law of Capital Markets at the Paris 10, Paris West – La Défense University, from 2006 to 2017.

He organised 2 colloquia on capital markets after the 2007 financial turmoil at the Warsaw School of Economics. He is a visiting professor to the Peking University and to the University of Montpellier.
